Your application should include the following:

1. **Coversheet**, available at link above.
2. **Research statement** (3-page maximum) that includes:
 - **Statement of the research problem** that your research is addressing, including theoretical rationale and research questions and/or hypotheses,
 - **Description of empirical research methods** and data sources,
 - **Statement of how the project will contribute** to the study of law and society, to one or more disciplines or sub-disciplines, and to your future research activities,
 - The **stage of your research project** at present (e.g., pre-, current, or post-data collection).
3. **Curriculum Vitae**
